

# DEED OF GIFT

## ***“PACIFIC COAST YACHTING ASSOCIATION TROPHY FOR RACING AND PARTICIPATION”***

The undersigned hereby presents to the Pacific Coast Yachting Association, hereafter referred to as PCYA a perpetual trophy to be awarded each year under the conditions set forth below, and to be known as the:

**Pacific Coast Yachting Association for Racing and Participation.**

### **I. ELIGIBILITY**

Contestants shall be limited to boats in the Adaptive/Inclusive sailing fleet. They shall satisfy the United States Sailing requirements for racing.

### **II. CONTEST**

The trophy shall be awarded on the basis of participation and scoring in One (1) Adaptive/Inclusive Sailing Regatta per year to be determined by the Current Rear Commodore of the PCYA. An effort shall be made to rotate the Regatta's that are scheduled and run by the Yacht Clubs and Members of the Pacific Coast Yachting Association.

### **III. SCORING**

In each race, the first boat to finish shall receive 3-1/4 points, the second boat shall receive 2 points, and the third boat shall receive 1 point. In addition, each boat starting shall receive 2 points and each boat finishing shall receive 3 additional points. The boat accumulating the greatest number of points under the above scoring system shall be awarded the trophy for that year. The scoring formula shall be applied to all divisions racing in the Regatta. In order for all the divisions have an equal numbers of races to be scored, the PCYA current Rear Commodore or designated representative of the PCYA, shall throw out the lowest scored races of the division(s) that finished more races.

### **IV. TROPHY**

The holder of the Trophy shall return it to PCYA prior to the annual installation meeting. The PCYA shall present the winner of the Trophy with a keeper trophy at the annual Installation and Awards Meeting. The perpetual Trophy shall be each year with the name of the winner. In the event that eligible participants compete in any year, no trophy shall be awarded.
